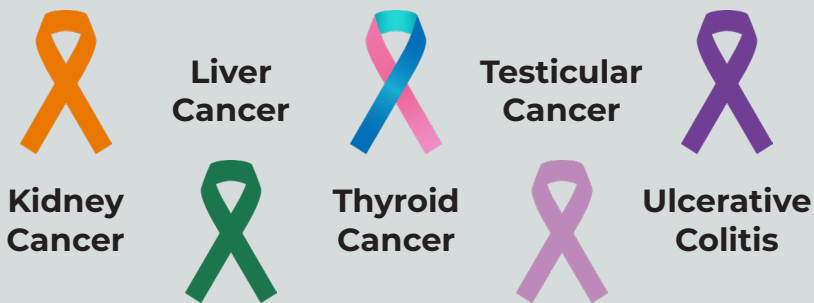


WHAT ARE PFAS?

PFAS are man-made chemicals that have been used in an extensive array of industrial and consumer products since the 1940s. As a result, these **forever chemicals** can be found in our air, clothing, cookware, drinking water, food, lakes, soil, and so much more.

Michigan has one of the highest rates of PFAS contamination in the country. In fact, a recent study published in the Science journal found as many as **3.2 million Michiganders** get their drinking water from aquifers containing detectable amounts of PFAS.
